1. **Arizona Child Abuse Hotline. 1-888-SOS-CHILD (1-888-767-2445)** A report of suspected child abuse, neglect, exploitation or abandonment is a responsible attempt to protect a child. Arizona law requires certain persons who suspect that a child has received non-accidental injury or has been neglected to report their concerns to DCS or local law enforcement (ARS §13-3620.A).
